Torah Portion:

Exodus 33:15-19

15 But then He said to Him, "If your presence does not go with me, don't let us go up from here!

16 For how would it be known that I or your people have found favor in your sight? Isn't it because you go with us, that distinguishes us from all the people on the face of the earth?"

17 Adonai answered Moses, "I will also do what you have said for you have found favor in my sight, and I know you by name."

18 Then he said, "Please, show me your glory!"

19 So he said, "I will cause all my goodness to pass before you, and call out the name of Adonai before you. I will be gracious towards whom I will be gracious and show mercy on whom I will be merciful."

Service Portion:

Zech 14:6-9, 16

6 In that day there will be no light, cold for frost.

7 It will be a day known only to Adonai, either day nor night - even in the evening time there will be light.

8 Moreover, in that day living waters will flow from Jerusalem, half towards the eastern sea and half towards the western sea, both in the summer and in the winter.

9 Adonai will then be king over all the earth. In that day Adonai will be Echad and his name will be Echad.

16 Then all the survivors from all the nations that attack Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, Adonai-Tzva'ot and to celebrate Sukkot.

John 7:37-39

37 "On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Yeshua stood up and cried out loudly, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

38 Whoever believes in Me, as the Scripture says, 'out of his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'"

39 Now He said this about the Spirit, whom those who trusted in Him were going to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, since Yeshua was not yet glorified.
