c. Satan's appetite is for total destruction.

2. Lions are peri-visual.

3. Lions are territorial.

a. Stop responding to fear.

b. Stand in faith.

Ephesians 6:13

c. Take the enemy's territory away—by faith in God's power.

d. Lions are careful.

1 Peter 5:9; James 4:7; 2 Corinthians 10:4; 1 John 4:4
