The Servant Rules

Using the Acronym “S.E.R.V.E.”

1. Serve what your spouse needs in spite of what you need, want, or understand.

2. Enjoy serving your spouse, and do it with a joyful attitude.

3. Reject score keeping, and do what you do with a spirit of grace and faith.

A. Serving redeems our spouse and changes the spirit of the relationship.

1 Peter 2:21; 1 Peter 3:1–4; 1 Peter 3:7

B. Serving puts us in our most powerful position to influence each other.

John 13:2–6

4. Vigilantly protect the priority of your marriage and the time and energy to serve your spouse.

5. Expect to be blessed, and don't get discouraged and give up.
