Key Scriptures: John 1:1; John 2:11; John 20:30; Revelation 19:13

Discuss

1. John records a lot of Bible stories about Jesus. Which is your favorite and why?
2. Pastor Robert shared the differences between the stories of Jesus in the book of John and the stories of Jesus in the books of Matthew, Mark, and Luke. Why do you think it is important to have multiple people sharing all Jesus did?
3. The book of John records many of the times Jesus said “I Am” because it reveals an aspect of God’s character in Jesus. What aspects of God’s nature have you experienced because of your relationship with Jesus?
4. Read John 13:34. What would the world look like if every believer obeyed Jesus’ commandment to love one another? Can you share an example of how you’ve put this into practice at home, at work, or elsewhere?
5. Is there someone you find hard to love? Take a moment and commit this person to Jesus. Ask God to help you change your heart and give you His love for this person.
6. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you through this message?

Takeaway

As we conclude, remember the following:

- John had divine aspects to his nature.
- John had human aspects to his nature.
- God used John despite his nature.

Prayer

Heavenly Father, thank You that no matter how we feel about ourselves, You can use us to impact the world and grow Your kingdom. Help us to not doubt the plans and purposes You have for our lives. We commit ourselves to You. Show us any areas where we are not loving others, and help us *love one another* just like Jesus asked us to. We trust and love You. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

Leader Tip

As a group leader, you may have times when you struggle with sickness or have something else unexpected arise that prevents you from leading. Identify someone in your group who could lead in your absence. Once you've identified that person, ask them if they would be up for leading and empower them by training them. Empowering people to help with different aspects of your meetings is also helpful as your group continues to grow over time.
